FOUR COMPONENTS OF LGAP:

1) PRE-SUBMISSION SEED FUNDING

A \$10,000 seed grant on new grant submissions.

2) ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

The Office of the Dean will contract with an External Grants Administration Specialist to assist the UMSOM grants administrators with reviewing all RFA requirements, organizing submission timelines, preparing budgets, compiling and reviewing documents, and entering data into NIH ASSIST for submission.

3) INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT

Contingent institutional support to demonstrate institutional commitment to your proposal.

4) POST-AWARD INCENTIVES

\$30,000 in unrestricted funds for any team that is awarded a new grant that was submitted through the LGAP Initiative for the PI to use at their discretion.
